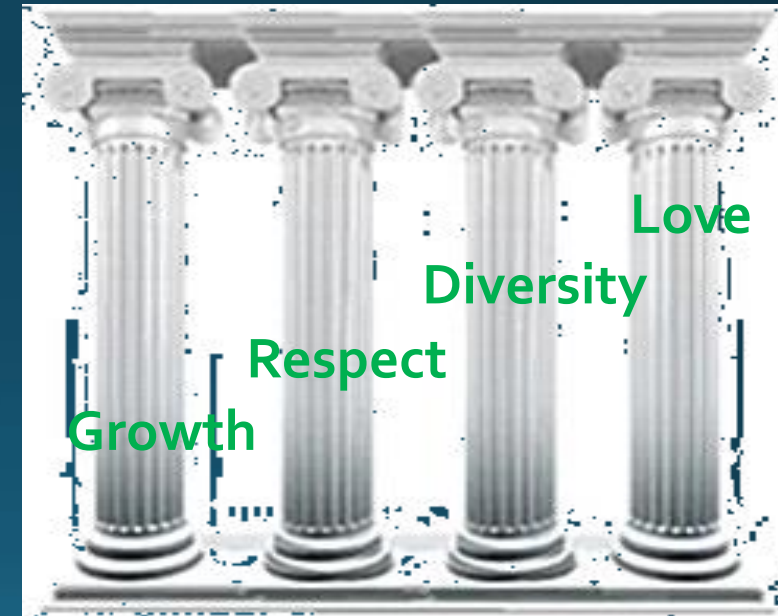
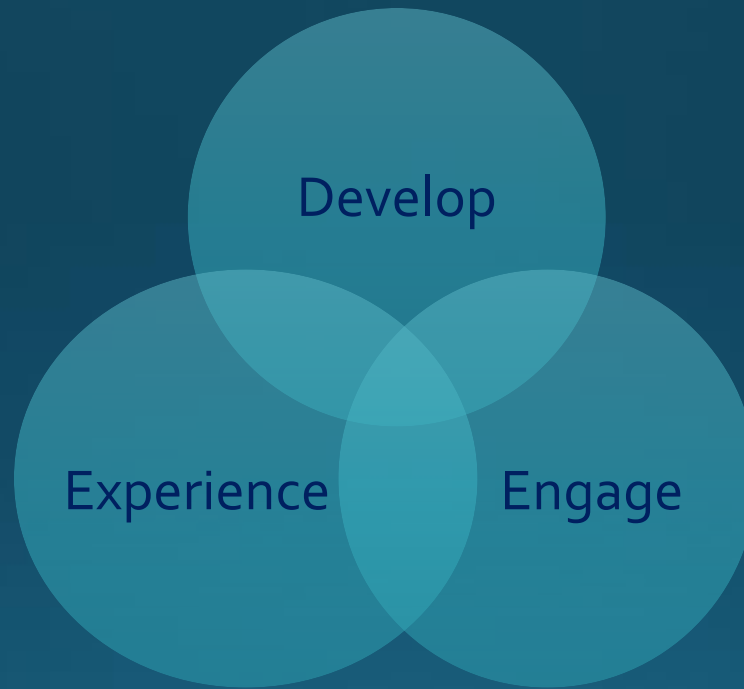

- Love and fellowship from the whole body of Christ (the whole congregation)


## 3. **Experience** the beauty of the Orthodox Church:

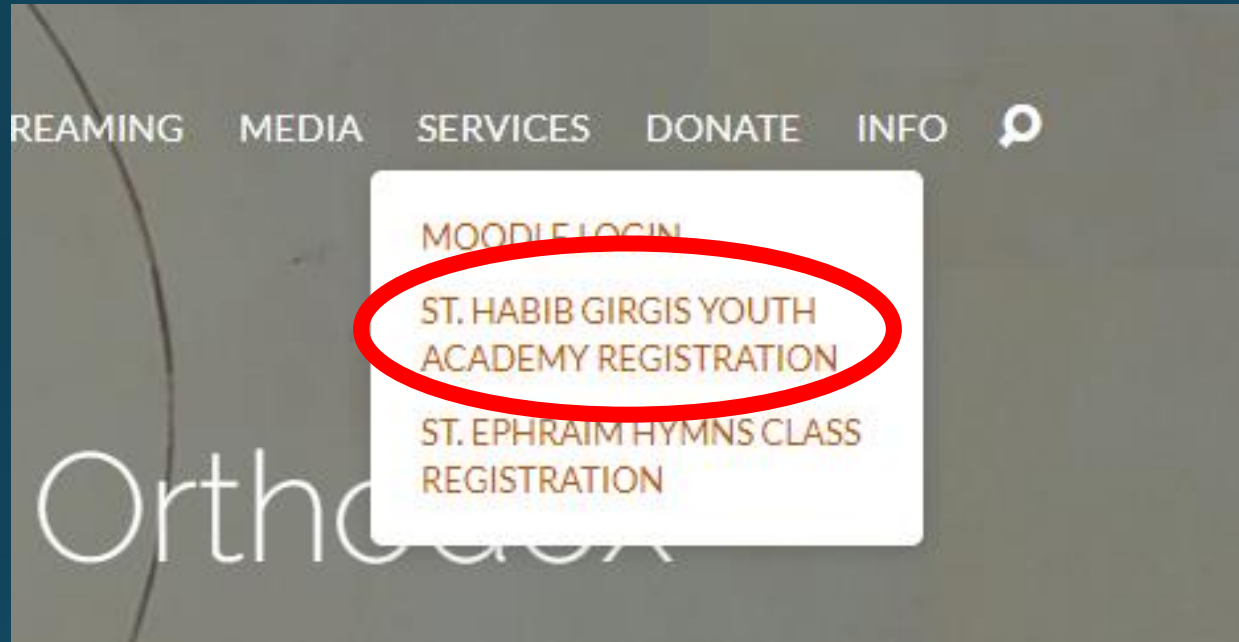
